Market Settlements Meter Adjustments

- GATS now receives meter adjustments automatically based on the new Settlements timeline of reporting meter adjustments during data load
 - Deadline is now 30 days after the month rather than 5 days
- GATS Administrators previously entered in the adjustments manually
- Any adjustments after this window will need to be done manually

Meter Picture Upload

- Pictures are stored to the generator for review by the GATS Administrators during High Generation review
- The picture will be associated with a month and year of generation for that generator

Certification Number Field Expanded


- Expanded the Certification Number field to allow for up to 50 characters
- All impacted reports were also updated to handle the longer character length




Recent Enhancements New Landing Page





- PJM EIS has redesigned the GATS landing pages to streamline the pages and make it easier for account holders to find the information they most frequently need.
- The following information is now viewable from the landing page:
 - » Account Summary
 - » Inbox/Outbox
 - » Favorites
 - » Asset Management
 - » Access to reports with drop down menu








Indicates an item that can be added to your favorites section, which is accessible on the landing page.

The More > link allows the user to access their entire list of assets.



All of the reports that were part of the Account Holder Report section can now be found under the drop down menus at the top of the page and are grouped together based on their function.

LANDING PAGE FOR GENERATOR ACCOUNT TYPE



1. Account Holder Reports

Reports can now be found under the drop down menus at the top of the page, grouped based on their function. The "Assets" drop down can be used to access reports for assets and generation.

2. Account Summary

All information pertaining to the certificates that will be created or have been created can be found in the **Account Summary** section. To access the information within this section simply click on the hyperlink to drill down to detailed information.

Inbox/Outbox

Inbox/Outbox has been moved up front and center to allow for easy access to manage the certificate transfers.

4. Favorites

The *Favorites* box is a new feature on the landing pages. It allows the user to keep their frequently used reports (pages) on the main page for easy access. Display My Assets is included in the *Favorites* as a default for the Generator Account Type. Use the circle icon that is found on the reports to easily add the reports you access frequently to your *Favorites* list.

5. Asset Management

Assets are now viewable from the new landing page. Generation can be entered by clicking on the icon next to the system under the Asset Management Section.



Aggregator Interface Updates

- Transfer REC Process updated to include transaction ID
- Additional processes included
 - Process Transfers Confirm, Reject, Withdraw RECs
 - Get Inbox/Outbox
 - Get Transfer History
 - Get RECs from their Active, CEPS and Bulletin Board subaccounts
- Document uploads

GATS Mobile

- A subset of features have been implemented to be accessible via a Mobile Device
 - Generator Registration
 - Generation Entry
 - Meter Picture Upload
 - Forgot Password
- Additional features will be converted as the .NET Conversion progresses



High Generation Review Process

- Nightly process runs and notifies the Subscriber via email that their generation is high and they need to provide documentation
- Evaluation is done based on the number of days between the last meter reading and the current meter reading


Batch Transfer Process



Automatic Certification for VA

 GATS will evaluate generators upon approval to determine if they are eligible in VA and apply the appropriate certification number

PV Watts Upgrade

API was updated with the latest version of PVWatts for creation of production estimates

.NET Conversion

Approximately 75% of GATS has been converted to .NET from Classic ASP

Enhanced Security

- Stronger login name required
- Password requirements changed to require a 10-digit alphanumeric combination
- Improved security questions with Forgot Password
- Reports display First and Last Name rather than login name

- Generator Account Type Updates (Dec 2015)
 - Generator Account Types will be unable to receive REC transfers
- .NET Conversion
 - Rewrite the Batch Transfer Screen (Dec 2015)
 - Continue converting the remaining 25% of the system (Ongoing)





Schedule H – Consent of Application Program Interface User

- Testing is required prior to gaining access to the production system
- Testing in production is strictly prohibited
- Minimize performance issues by scheduling jobs during non-peak hours
- Maintain a 90% success rate for each method used
- Fees will be charged for advanced capabilities of the Aggregator Interface
