

Generation Attribute Tracking System (GATS) Operating Rules Changes in Rev 1 dated June 30, 2005

Presented at the GATS Subscriber Group Meeting July 7, 2005



Changes to Operating Rules (Rev 1)

- General Made miscellaneous corrections based on comments received after the April 15th Subscriber Group Meeting
- Section 2 Definition of Terms
 - Modified definition of Billable State, Certificate(s), and Retail LSE Subaccount
 - Added definitions for Emission Protocol, Retail Load Serving Entity, and Voluntary Market
- Section 6.5 Added paragraph 6 describing use of an approved Emissions Protocol for Multi-fuel Generation Units
- Section 8 and Appendix C added capability for the GATS Administrator to retroactively update eligibility for state programs on certificates created during the current trading period, upon request by an authorized state agency



Changes to Operating Rules (Rev 1)

- Section 9.2 added capability to allow Standing Orders to be defined for a fixed period of time and irrevocable by the Transferor (similar to Forward Certificate Transfer functionality in NEPOOL GIS).
- Appendix A updated Comparison of RPS Programs in PJM States
- Appendix C Generator Static Data Fields
 - additional fields changed to be required
 - updated Fuel Types table
- Appendix F deleted two Administrator reports:
 - Serving LSE report
 - Delinquent Unit Exports report
- Appendix G Added state agencies in North Carolina (due to integration of Dominion on May 1)
